“God gives a fresh start to those ready to quit.” Ps. 145:14 (Msg)

1. Seize _____ the moment.

“As Jesus... left town, a great crowd was following. A blind beggar named Bartimaeus was sitting beside the road as Jesus was going by. When Bartimaeus heard that Jesus was nearby, he began to shout, ‘Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!’”

“Jesus said, ‘No procrastination! No backward looks. You can’t put off God’s kingdom till tomorrow. Seize the day!’”

2. Tame _____ your fear.

“Many of the people scolded him and told him to be quiet. But he shouted even more loudly, ‘Have mercy on me!’”

3. Announce _____ your faith.

4. Receive _____ God’s Grace.
