

10 Questions For Examining Your Life Pt. 2

1. First Commandment: God

You shall have no other gods before me. (Exodus 20:3)

2. Second Commandment: Worship

You shall not make for yourselves an idol. (Exodus 20:4)

3. Third Commandment: False Religion

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God. (Exodus 20:7)

4. Fourth Commandment: Time, Work, and Rest

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work. (Exodus 20:8-9)

5. Fifth Commandment: Authority

Honor your father and your mother. (Exodus 20:12)

6. Sixth Commandment: PEACE

"You must not murder.

Exodus 20:13 (NLT)

"You have heard that our ancestors were told, 'You must not murder. If you commit murder, you are subject to judgment.'²² But I say, if you are even angry with someone, you are subject to judgment! If you call someone an idiot, you are in danger of being brought before the court. And if you curse someone, you are in danger of the fires of hell.

Matthew 5:21-22 (NLT)

7. Seventh Commandment: PURITY

"You must not commit adultery.

Exodus 20:14 (NLT)

But I say, anyone who even looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

Matthew 5:28 (NLT)

8. Eighth Commandment: INTEGRITY

"You must not steal.

Exodus 20:15 (NLT)

"Will a man rob God? Yet you are robbing Me! But you say, 'How have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings.⁹ 'You are cursed with a curse, for you are robbing Me, the whole nation of you!

Malachi 3:8-9 (NASB)

9. Ninth Commandment: TRUTH

"You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Exodus 20:16 (NASB)

10. Tenth Commandment: CONTENTMENT

"You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife or his male servant or his female servant or his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

Exodus 20:17 (NASB)

Philippians 4:12 (NASB)

In what ways do you least reflect the image and likeness of God?
