The Bible, as the Mind of God in Print, tells us:

- There are right ways and wrong ways to live.
- There are right things and wrong things to do.
- There are right beliefs and wrong beliefs.
- There are right behaviors and wrong behavior.

For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart. Hebrews 4:12 (NASB)

1. HUMILITY.

- **HONOR one another above yourselves.**

Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good. ¹⁰ Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; Romans 12:9-10 (NASB)

"Live in harmony with one another..." (Romans 12:16)
"Serve one another in love." (Galatians 5:13)
"Wash one another's feet." (John 13:14)

- **SUBMIT to one another out of reverence for Christ.**

Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, ²⁰ always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²¹ Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. Ephesians 5:19-21 (NIV)

Submissive roles for Christians:

1. To God
2. To government
3. To elders
4. Wives to husbands
5. Children to parents
6. To one another

- **In HUMILITY consider others better than yourselves.**

Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; Philippians 2:3 (NASB)

- **Clothe yourselves with HUMILITY toward one another.**

You younger men, likewise, be subject to your elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE. 1 Peter 5:5 (NASB)

2. TEACH/CORRECT

- **INSTRUCT one another.**

And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able also to admonish one another. Romans 15:14 (NASB)

- **ADMONISH one another.**

Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God. Colossians 3:16 (NASB)
