WHAT TO REMEMBER ABOUT THE PAST:

1. REMEMBER WHEN YOU FIRST

Came to Jesus Christ

"Don't ever forget those early days when you first learned about Christ." Heb.10:32a (NLT)

2. REMEMBER

The Miracles God has Done

"Remember the miracles He has done, His wonders, and His decisions." 1 Chron. 16:12 (NCV)

"Remember that the Lord is the only God and that He is faithful." Deut. 7:9 (TEV)

WHAT TO REMEMBER IN THE PRESENT:

3. REMEMBER TO BE

Gracious

"Make allowance for each other's faults and forgive the person who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." Col. 3:13 (NLT)

4. REMEMBER TO BE

Generous

"Remember the words of the Lord Jesus: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'" Acts 20:35 (NLT)

"Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously." 2 Cor. 9:6 (NIV)

"You will be glorifying God through your generous gifts. For your generosity to them will prove that you are obedient to the Good News of Christ." 2 Cor. 9:13 (NLT)

WHAT TO REMEMBER FOR THE FUTURE:

5. REMEMBER GOD

will be with you
