### **Luke 22:41-42 (NASB)**

<sup>41</sup> And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and *began* to pray,

<sup>42</sup> saying, "**Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done.**"

- Acceptance.

### **1 Samuel 3:9 (NASB)**

<sup>9</sup> And Eli said to Samuel, "Go lie down, and it shall be if He calls you, that you shall say, 'Speak, LORD, for Your servant is listening.'" So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

- Reluctance.

### **James 1:6-8 (NASB)**

<sup>6</sup> But he must ask in faith without any doubting, for the one who doubts is like the surf of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind.

<sup>7</sup> For that man ought not to expect that he will receive anything from the Lord,

<sup>8</sup> *being* a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.
