## THE TWO GREAT TEACHERS:

### 1. **Wisdom.**

*The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel:[2] for attaining wisdom and discipline; for understanding words of insight;[3] for acquiring a disciplined and prudent life, doing what is right and just and fair;[4] for giving prudence to the simple, knowledge and discretion to the young--[5] let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance.*

### 2. **Experience.**

## THREE KEYS TO REMAINING TEACHABLE:

### B. **Bring** YOUR **eyes, ears,** AND **heart** TO THE CLASSROOM.

*He who has ears, let him hear." [10] The disciples came to him and asked, "Why do you speak to the people in parables?"[11]*

*He replied, "The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. [12] Whoever has will be given more, and he will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken from him. [13] This is why I speak to them in parables: "Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand. In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: "You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.*
