1 Corinthians 10:31 (NIV)

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it <u>all</u> for the glory of God.

1. How do I <u>LOVE</u> what I do? Colossians 3:23-24 (NASB)

Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, ²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve.

2. How do I do what I <u>LOVE?</u> Psalm 37:4-5 (NASB)

Delight yourself in the LORD; And He will give you the desires of your heart. ⁵ Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, and He will do it.

3. Remember we <u>GET</u> to work. Exodus 20:9 (NASB)

"Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

2 Thessalonians 3:10 (NASB)

For even when we were with you, we used to give you this order: if anyone is not willing to work, then he is not to eat, either.

Philippians 2:14-15 (NASB)

Do all things without grumbling or disputing; ¹⁵ so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world.
