What Makes God Happy (Colossians 1:9-12)

- 1. To SERVE God
- 2. To KNOW God
- 3. To be STRENGTHENED by God
- 4. To THANK God

... and what doesn't...

There are six things which the Lord hates,
Yes, seven which are an abomination to Him:
Haughty eyes, a lying tongue,
And hands that shed innocent blood,
A heart that devises wicked plans,
Feet that run rapidly to evil,
A false witness who utters lies,

And one who spreads strife among brothers. Proverbs 6:16-19 (NASB)

...a **troublemaker** in the **family**. (MSG)

... a **person who stirs up conflict** in the **community**. (NIV)

... And *one who spreads discord* among *brothers*. (AMP)

Definition of *discord*

1a: lack of agreement or harmony (as between persons, things, or ideas)
1b: active quarreling or conflict resulting from discord among persons or
factions: STRIFE

2 in music

a: combination of musical sounds that strikes the ear harshly

b: a harsh or unpleasant sound

Why Is THIS So Troubling to God?

1. The EFFECTIVENESS of the CHURCH is diminished.

Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt among yourselves, and be at peace with each other.

Mark 9:50 (NIV)

¹⁴ "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; ¹⁵ nor does *anyone* light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and

it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

2. What God PUT TOGETHER, we TAKE APART.

³ Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?" "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' ⁵ and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will

become one flesh'? ⁶ So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate." Matthew 19:3-6 (NIV)

How Do We Prevent It?

3. We CHOOSE to be UNOFFENDABLE.

Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to <u>mutual</u> <u>edification</u>. Romans 14:19 (NIV)

Make every effort to keep <u>the unity of the Spirit</u> through the bond of peace.

Ephesians 4:3 (NIV)

What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from <u>your</u> <u>desires</u> that battle within you? James 4:1 (NIV)

Don't have anything to do with <u>foolish and stupid arguments, because</u> <u>you know they produce quarrels</u>. ²⁴ And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. ²⁵ Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, ²⁶ and that they will <u>come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil</u>, who has taken them captive to do his will. 2 Timothy 2:23-26 (NIV)
