## 1. Paul WAITED.

## 2. His spirit was **PROVOKED**.

So he was reasoning in the synagogue with the Jews and the Godfearing Gentiles, and in the market place every day with those who happened to be present. <sup>18</sup> And also some of the Epicurean and Stoic philosophers were conversing with him. Some were saying, "What would this idle babbler wish to say?" Others, "He seems to be a proclaimer of strange deities,"—because he was preaching Jesus and the resurrection. <sup>19</sup> And they took him and brought him to the Areopagus, saying, "May we know what this new teaching is which you are proclaiming? <sup>20</sup> "For you are bringing some strange things to our ears; so we want to know what these things mean." <sup>21</sup> (Now all the Athenians and the strangers visiting there used to spend their time in nothing other than telling or hearing something new.)
