Men's

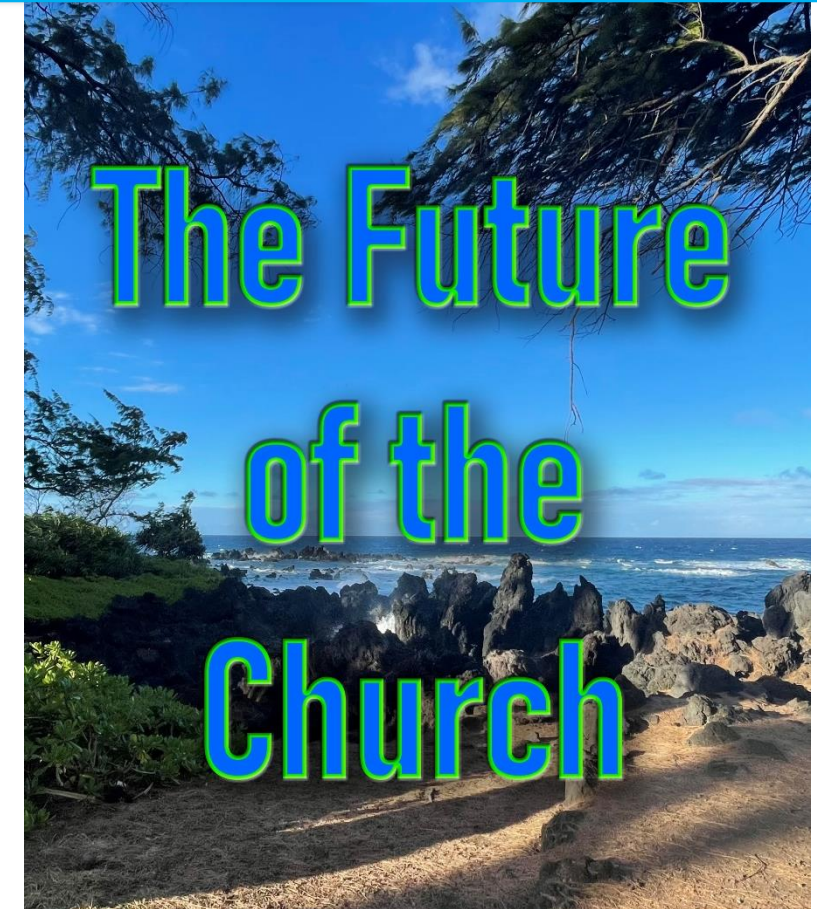
