Women's Ministry

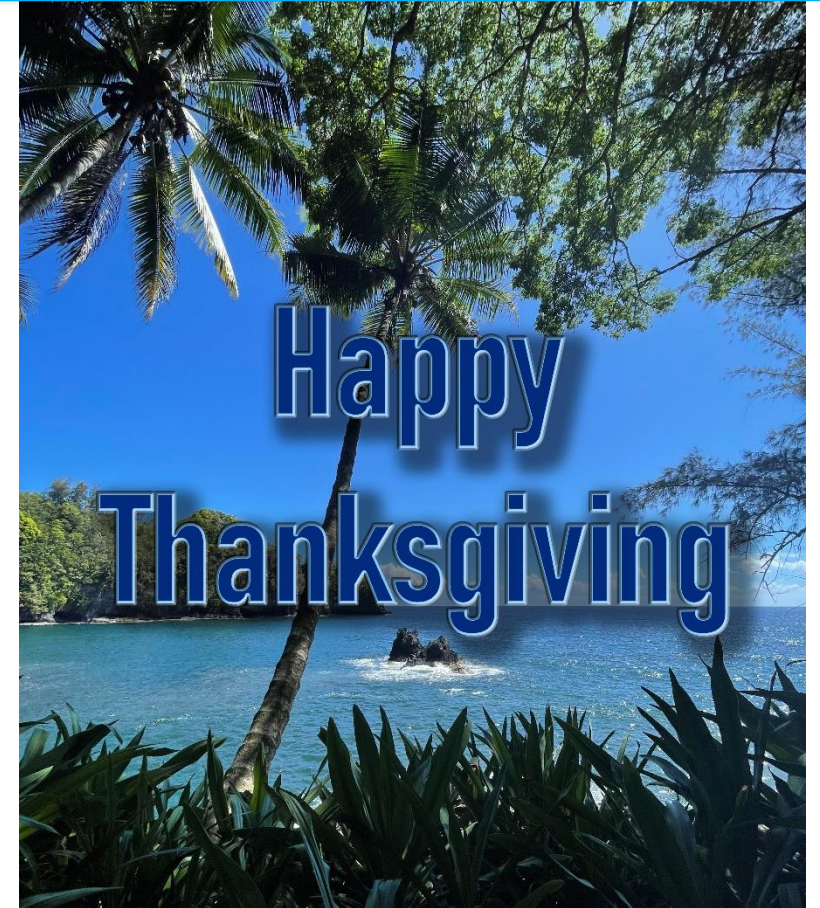
