Men's

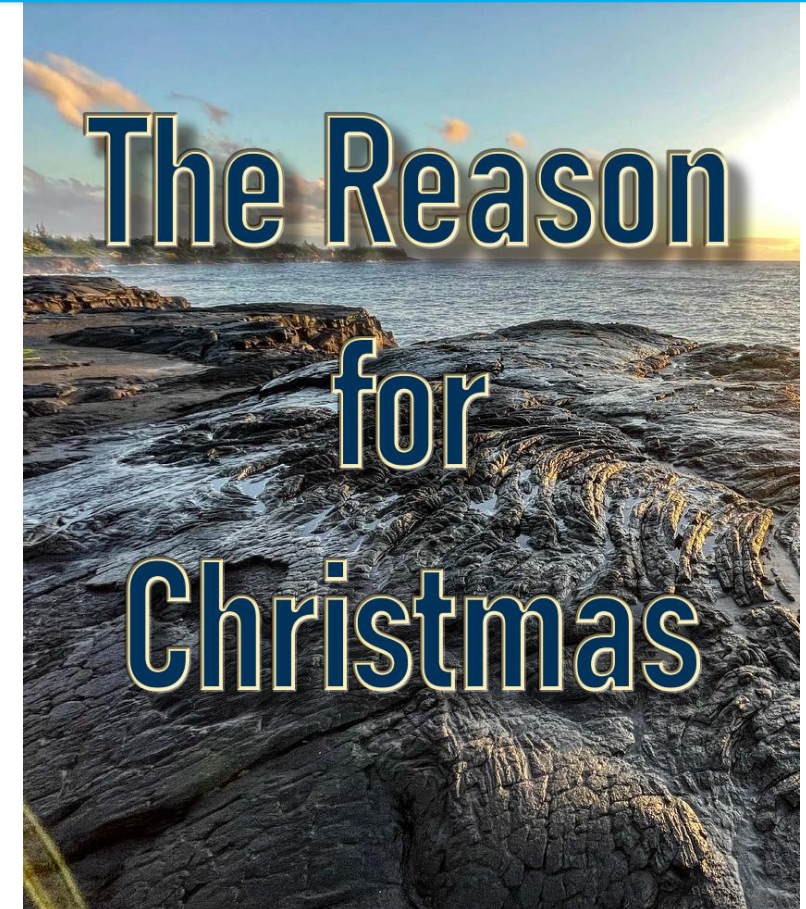
